Crochet Coffee Mug Cozy Pattern

This is a pattern for a coffee mug cozy. It will fit any regular size coffee mug, and stretch to fit bigger sizes. It can be adapted to fit larger or smaller mugs by increasing or decreasing the amount of rows after the 6th row. This pattern uses only single crochet and is worked in the back loops of stitches to form a ribbed effect. However, it can be worked in both loops if you prefer! It employs increasing and decreasing single crochet so make sure you know how to do that first!

Gauge: You can use any size crochet hook, but 4.5mm works best.



Key:

Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Sc dec. = single crochet decrease

Begin by Ch. 6

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc in next 4 spaces. Ch 1, turn (5 sc)

Row 2 (from here on, work in back loops): 2 sc in 1st space. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (6 sc)

Row 3: 2 sc in 1st space. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (7 sc)

Row 4: 2 sc in 1st space. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (8 sc)

Row 5: 2 sc in 1st space. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (9 sc)

Row 6: 2 sc in 1st space. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (10 sc)

Rows 7-18: 10 sc across. Ch 1, turn. (10 sc)

Row 19: 1 sc dec. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (9 sc)

Row 20: 1 sc dec. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (8 sc)

Row 21: 1 sc dec. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (7 sc)

Row 22: 1 sc dec. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (6 sc)

Row 23: 1 sc dec. Sc across. Ch 1, turn. (5 sc)

Row 24: 1 sc dec. Sc across. Ch 4, turn. Sl st into 1st sc of last row to form a button loop. (4 sc)

Sew in loose ends and attach a fashionable button to the end without the loop. Enjoy your hot beverage without scalding those hands of yours!
